All Funeral Directors are legally required to publish this Price list for a standardised set of products and services. This is to help you consider your options and make choices, allowing you to compare prices between different Funeral Directors because prices can vary.

ATTENDED FUNERAL (Funeral Directors charges only) This is a funeral where family and friends have a ceremony, event or service for the deceased person, at the same time that they attend their burial or cremation	£2195
Taking care of all necessary legal and administrative arrangements	£595
Collecting and transporting the deceased person from the place of death, normally within 15 miles of the Funeral Directors premises, safely into the Funeral Directors care (<i>Inside of normal office hours</i>)	£150
Care of the deceased person before the funeral in appropriate facilities. The deceased person will be looked after safely at our branch premises	£360
Providing a suitable coffin - This will be made from high quality oak veneer	£450
Viewing of the deceased person for family and friends, by appointment with the Funeral Director (<i>where viewing is requested by the customer</i>)	£40
At a date and time that you agree with the Funeral Director, taking the deceased person directly to the agreed cemetery or crematorium (normally within 20 miles of the Funeral Directors premises) in a Hearse or other appropriate vehicle	£600
UNATTENDED FUNERAL This is a funeral where family and friends may choose to have a ceremony, event or service for the deceased person, but they do not attend the burial or cremation itself	
Burial (Funeral Directors charges only)	£1250
Cremation (Funeral Directors charges plus the cremation fee) ²	£1695
FEES YOU MUST PAY (in addition to the above)	
For an 'Attended or Unattended Burial' funeral, the burial fee is ¹ : In this local area, the typical cost of the burial fee for local residents is:	£366 - £5475 £560
For a new grave, you will also need to pay for the plot: for an existing grave with a memorial in place, you may need to pay a removal / replacement fee. In addition, the cemetery may charge a number of other fees	
For an 'Attended Cremation' funeral, the cremation fee ² : In this local area, the typical cost of a cremation is:	£650 - £1400

ADDITIONAL FUNERAL DIRECTOR PRODUCTS AND SERVICES This Funeral Director can supply a range of optional, additional products and services. Or can arrange (on your behalf) for a third party to supply them. Examples include:	
Additional mileage (price per mile)	£1.50
Additional transfers of the deceased person(s) <i>For example: To their home or a place of worship, price per transfer</i>	Not Offered
Collection and delivery of ashes	£80
Embalming	£140
Funeral officiant (<i>For example: Celebrant, Minister of Religion etc</i>)	£228 - £300
Services supplied outside of normal office hours	£ on request
<i>The Funeral Director can give you a full list of what they can supply. They are likely to charge for these additional products and services, so you may choose to take care of some arrangements without their involvement, or can use a different supplier</i>	

¹ This fee (which is sometimes called the interment fee) is the charge made for digging and closing a new grave, or for reopening and closing an existing grave

² In England, Wales and Northern Ireland, you will usually need to pay doctors' fees as well. This is the charge for two doctors to sign the Medical Certificates for Cremation
